



Trade fair regulations ProWing International (valid from 01 January 2024)

The aim of these trade fair regulations is to implement the trade fair idea ProWing International to regulate.

The idea behind the trade fair is a trade fair for model aircraft builders to carry out. This trade fair is intended to have a higher standard reflect the greatest possible range of products. These Trade fair regulations serve as guidelines for everyone involved and are included to adhere to the spirit of the fair.

The organizer does everything possible to help you as an exhibitor within the framework of these trade fair regulations, participation in ProWing Internationally as pleasant and successful as possible design.

1. Organizer and trade fair management

The organizer of ProWing International is ERL Event GmbH & Co. KG with the support of the Flugsportgemeinschaft Soest e.V. During the event, the organizer will be represented by the Trade fair management, consisting of representatives from ERL Event GmbH & Co. KG and the Flugsportgemeinschaft Soest e.V.

2. Scope of the exhibition:

Everyone is available for exhibition, presentation and sales industrial and commercial products from the model aircraft industry and industry-related products such as tools, adhesives and materials etc. with the following exceptions authorized:

- used items (the only exception are demonstration models) and Items from bankruptcy estates
- as well as all exhibits that belong to the toy category.

The available exhibition space in the hall and the outdoor area is in keeping with the underlying trade fair idea divided up. The focus is on the manufacturers and distributors and as wide a range of high-quality products as possible offer. We reserve the right to limit the exhibition space for foam models.

The trade fair management reserves the right to keep goods from the trade fair stands to have those who were not logged in removed and to contradict the planned character of the trade fair. Exhibitors of model aircraft and model drives (combustion engines, electric motors and turbines) have the opportunity to demonstrate products such as power systems, remote controls, propellers etc. can only be used within the scope of the slots (model aircraft or products as part of an air show on all days of the trade fair. Other model drives) are presented.

The slots for the first day of the trade fair will be announced before the start of the event Event drawn. For the remaining two days of the trade fair the slots are sorted based on the draw so that the greatest possible fairness in the slot distribution is achieved. The exhibitor has no legal right for a specific slot (time or duration). This also applies to slots that must be cancelled due to weather conditions.

3. Registration and admission

Registration as an exhibitor is done online via the corresponding registration form which is available on the website ProWing can be found under the "Exhibitors" section. The registration deadline is 4 weeks before the first day of the trade fair.

Exceptions are only possible if free stand space can be occupied without rescheduling. Consequences caused by incorrect or

incomplete completion registration documents are not at the expense of the organizer, but exclusively at the expense of the organizer exhibitor. The completed registration is binding for every exhibitor. However, this does not give you a right to participate in ProWing to be derived internationally.

ERL Event GmbH & Co. KG confirms receipt of the registration documents via automatic email response. After the exhibitor will receive a review of the documents at a later date time by email or by post an order confirmation. Sending the invoice for the stand rental and any additional costs that may arise are stated in the registration form about 6 weeks before the start of the event. Should the Organizers do not make the decision for the exhibitor to allow this the organizer will inform you promptly after registration.

The full payment must be settled in 14 days at the latest after invoicing (the postmark is valid). Through the payment instruction from the issuer his registration becomes legally binding and he accepts the Trade fair regulations.

The exhibitor can withdraw his registration at least 4 weeks before trade fair begins. In this case we charge a processing fee of 10 percent invoice amount. If you withdraw after this deadline or in the event of no-show, the full invoice amount will be charged if the organizer cannot rent the booth-place to another exhibitor.

If insolvency proceedings are initiated against an exhibitor is pending or the opening is due to insufficient cost coverage is rejected, the organizer is responsible for rejecting one Exhibitor registration authorized.

Admission and stand allocation are based on this. The trade fair regulations, the available exhibition areas and the distribution of the product range are exclusively determined by the Organizer. There can therefore be no law of any kind for admission as an exhibitor. A common law is from an approval and stand assignment once granted cannot be derived in any way.

The organizer is free to accept registrations without specifying reasons to reject.

The organizer reserves the right not to do so within the scope to point out suitable exhibition goods for the event and to request distance from the exhibition stand.

Exhibition samples are available for the entire duration of the trade fair to prevent visitors from coming to the trade fair feel deceived by advance notices. This is also true for trade fair stands that are dismantled prematurely!

Exhibitors may only offer products and presented by the exhibitor in his registration announced and approved by the trade fair management. This applies to the entire airport/trade fair grounds is not just limited to the trade fair tents.

The admission of an exhibitor to the trade fair does not replace commercial authorization to sell its products. The provider is solely responsible for compliance with all legal requirements in connection with the sale and exhibition of products.

All documents and ID cards required for the trade fair will be handed out in the trade fair office on the construction days.

The organizer will select the stand locations to the best of his ability and knowledge. A claim to one there is no specific location, even if

it is on the part of the organizer tries to accommodate the wishes of the exhibitors take into account.

Should a replanning by the Organizer be necessary within the trade fair tents or in the outdoor area is no reason for a registration cancellation.

If after the trade fair stand has been allocated and therefore after payment of the stand costs and additional costs is known will result in insolvency proceedings against the exhibitor has been opened or has been rejected due to a lack of cost coverage the trade fair stand allocation will be carried out by the organizer cancelled. The exhibitor then has no claims against the organizer and can therefore have no reimbursement of stand costs including additional costs on demand.

This is due to the exhibition stand allocation for the exhibitor established tenancy law extends to the point in time between the first day of construction at 9:00 a.m. and the last dismantling day 6 p.m.

Exhibition goods and trade fair stands or parts thereof must be completed by 6:00 p.m. on the last day of dismantling Event area (Soest / Bad Sassendorf airfield) to remove. Otherwise the organizer reserves the right to remove goods and store at the expense and account of the exhibitor.

4. Data protection

By registering for the ProWing International event the exhibitor also gives consent to the organizer to publish the data concerning him regardless of trade fair catalogs, exhibitor lists, etc conflicting provisions of the Data Protection Act.

5. Subletting of allocated exhibition space

A wholly or partially paid or free of charge transfer of the rights established by the space rental: Third parties are not permitted. Therefore, except for the registered one exhibitors and registered sub-exhibitors at the allocated exhibition space no one else's goods exhibit, offer or advertise for them. The exchange of exhibition areas without the consent of the trade fair management is not permitted.

A joint registration from different exhibitors is possible. However, each exhibitor has to deal separately with the reference to a shared use of exhibition space with the other exhibitors.

6. Delivery and removal of exhibition goods

All exhibits and goods of the exhibitors must be delivered to the exhibition grounds at their expense and risk. The structure of the exhibition stand must be set up by 10 p.m. on the last day of construction.

If you do not receive it by this date, it will expire Exhibition space in favor of the organizer, who then may dispose of it at its own discretion. A claim for compensation or reimbursement of the stand rent or other fees do not arise from this.

7. Design and external appearance of the Exhibition areas

The exhibition areas will be swept clean for the exhibitors hand over. For technical or organizational reasons the allocated exhibition space can vary in size slightly from the assigned size. This However, the deviation is a maximum of 15 cm in depth and in the length. This deviation does not justify a reduction of the stand rent. The same also applies to Space restrictions due to possible supports and pillars and power distributors.

The design of the allocated stand space is the responsibility of the Exhibitor. Any instructions from the trade fair management are to be taken into account follow and adhere to the guidelines of these trade fair regulations.

The exhibitor is responsible for designing the exhibition stand and to make sure that the exhibition stand has usual safety requirements and poses no danger to represents visitors or exhibitors. In addition, the Trade fair stand must meet average requirements of a trade fair stand. I.e. beer table sets or trestle tables are only permitted if they are disguised and therefore not recognizable as such.

In order to have an attractive trade fair, the trade fair stand must be interesting, visually appealing in good taste. The Trade fair management reserves the right before, hints and, in extreme cases, instructions to give changes.

The exhibited goods must be returned by the end of the last trade fair remain on display throughout the day of the trade fair. An early evacuation of the Exhibition stands is not permitted.

The exhibition stand must be occupied by at least one person on all days during opening hours.

Each exhibitor has their stand during the entire trade fair with the company name and the complete to mark the address.

Each exhibitor has access to a 230V power connection Disposal. The provision of this connection is included in the rental price. For further installation within the exhibitor is responsible for the exhibition stand. He provides one proper and safety requirements appropriate installation safe and liable for any Damage occurring due to incorrect installation.

Doors, escape doors and facilities for the Firefighting facilities may not be installed.

The construction of the stand boundaries with advertising signs, Exhibition models etc. is only after the previous arrangement with the trade fair management is permitted. This also applies to outdoor exhibition stands.

Multi-story exhibition stands are only permitted after written approval Permission from the trade fair management. Here is one appropriate statics must be presented. There is no requirement for approval.

8. Cleaning and waste disposal

Cleaning of the exhibition stand is only permitted outside of the opening hours. **The aisles in front of and next to the exhibition stand are through the exhibitors in consultation with the exhibition neighbors to keep swept clean.** The resulting garbage is to be disposed of in the waste containers provided (residual waste and waste paper/cardboard). Packaging boxes must be shredded and bundled and stored in dispose of waste paper in appropriate containers. Should this not be done to an appropriate extent, the organizer will arrange this at the exhibitor's expense.

9. Advertising

Any advertising (flyers, posters, banners, beach flags, etc.) outside the exhibition stand is only permitted with the permission of Exhibition management.

Music and film performances as part of product presentations are generally permitted as long as the performance does not unduly inconvenience to other exhibitors. The Registration of such performances and payment any GEMA fees that may be due are to be paid by the exhibitor cause.

The use of loudspeaker systems at the exhibition stand for the presentation of goods is out of consideration for others exhibitors prohibited. Offering goods at bargain prices, i.e prices that significantly exceed the average offer price fall short is considered a blatant offer and is therefore prohibited.

Visitors or other people are prohibited from distributing Advertising material and selling products only with permission from the trade fair management is permitted. Permits can only be granted to companies from outside the industry to ensure that exhibitors do not suffer any disadvantages. Violators will receive a reprimand from Event site without entitlement to reimbursement Entrance fee results. In addition, in the case of unauthorized Sales activities are subsequently subject to a flat-rate stand fee of 300 euros.

10. Liability

The exhibitor is liable for any damage he or she causes agents and employees. He is also liable for accidents that occur to him or his agents and employees cause. When taking part in the air show, pilots must have a sufficient liability insurance and proof of knowledge must be provided for each participating pilot. Please make sure that demonstration pilots are at a trade fair "Flying

commercially" and therefore a special form of flying Liability insurance is required.

11. List of exhibitors

Entry in the exhibitor directory takes place mandatory and is included in the rental price of the stand space. The publication takes place on the ProWing website International (www.prowing.de) and includes the Company name including the link to the respective website of the exhibitor.

The entry information in the exhibitor directory is specified by the exhibitor in the registration form and by the organizer to the best of his knowledge and belief implemented. Information errors provided by the issuer or in the implementation will be corrected free of charge if necessary, but do not result in any claims on the part of the exhibitor.

12. Exhibitor/Pilot IDs

Every exhibitor will receive one of these in the trade fair office at the trade fair Quantity corresponding to stand size (see registration form) of exhibitor/pilot passes.

Other exhibitors/ Pilot licenses are subject to a fee (see registration form). The exhibitor/pilot ID cards come with a name provided, non-transferable and during the assembly time must be worn visibly on clothing.

13. Opening hours

The exhibition center is open to the public in the previously published opening hours. Exhibitors can come on the days of the trade fair one hour before opening upon presentation of the Exhibitor pass on the exhibition grounds or in the Exhibition tent. The exhibition tent and the exhibition stands in the outdoor areas are to leave not later than one hour after the end of the trade fair to leave. The security instructions must be followed.

14. Assembly and dismantling times

The construction days are the Wednesday and Thursday before event starting at 8:00 a.m. Construction ends on Wednesday at 8 p.m. and Thursday at 10 p.m. Longer setup times are only granted in consultation with the organizer and against payment of security staff.

Dismantling must be completed by Monday evening 8 p.m. after the event.

15. Disciplinary measures

- Every exhibitor must follow the local and commercial police specifications and the instructions of the fire department/the Fire protection officer, the trade fair management and the security. The trade fair management is practicing during the entire duration of the event including the setup and house rules are exercised during dismantling.
- The storage of flammable items is prohibited in the exhibition tent. Liquids such as fuels and solvents only amounts of current consumption permitted. Amounts in addition, also for sale are in appropriate fireproof storage facilities outside of the exhibition tent. A review is reserved the trade fair management.
- For sale are flammable or even explosive items Substances excluded.
- Devices or others that have an open creating flames is not permitted in the exhibition tent.
- The electrical installation must comply with legal requirements and regulations.
- Demonstrations outside of the air show, which cause noise development is only permitted in the Action area.
- During the air show, all participating pilots must follow the instructions of the flight management and the trade fair management as well as the legal requirement regulations and the provisions of the promotion/ Event approval.

- The exhibitor is responsible for compliance of all regulations legal requirements including any applicable ones responsible for occupational safety rules. Non-compliance will result in immediate dissolution of the rental agreement for the exhibition stand without entitlement result in compensation.

- Smoking is prohibited in the exhibition hall.

- Charging batteries outside of trade fair times and without supervision is strictly prohibited. This applies to this Exhibition tent and also for hangars in which models are subordinated.

16. Oversight and Disclaimer

The organizer ensures a general fire watch and trade fair security by a security company. However, assumes no liability for damage, theft or other cases of damage.

If the organizer provides shelter (e.g. Hangar) is offered for model aircraft, parking takes place of the models there at your own risk and responsibility. The organizer assumes no liability for damage of any kind by third parties, as a result of sabotage, higher violence or other events.

There are no security personnel provided by the exhibitors permitted.

For damage to persons and property during the event, i.e. on the event site, the trade fair management assumes no liability unless the organizer can be proven to be grossly negligent.

The organizer is also not liable for events that occur force majeure, political events or official events orders are caused.

It is expressly stated that the organizer has no responsibility whatsoever responsibility or liability for industrial accidents of any kind damage to property or exhibits sparks, fire, electricity and/or water damage or for assumes poor business performance. The exhibitor It is your responsibility to take out appropriate insurance cover to be retained.

The organizer is exempt from any obligation to pay compensation for property and damage Personal injury to the exhibitor, its staff and the freed from material goods brought to the exhibition grounds.

The exhibition stands owned by the exhibitors, exhibition exhibits, storage materials or pavilions on the outdoor area or in the exhibition tents or exhibition halls are not permitted by the organizer insured against any risks. The organizer assumes no liability or compensation in the event of damage.

The organizer also assumes no liability whatsoever no compensation for weather-related damage such as storms, Heat, lightning etc. There will also be no liability and no Compensation for damage to machines and equipment as well as for loss of earnings due to interruptions in the Power supply taken over.

17. Traffic and parking ban on the exhibition grounds

The exhibition grounds may only be accessed by vehicles which have appropriate marking. The rental price includes one parking permit per exhibitor. More Parking permits can be purchased for a fee upon registration. Exhibitors will receive their parking permits in the Trade fair office with the other trade fair documents. Through this Parking permits do not automatically result in a claim of a parking space in the immediate vicinity of the exhibition tent.

After the vehicles have been unloaded, they must be parked in designated parking spaces.

Please be considerate of others and make space if you have already unloaded. Have your parking permit clearly visible and with you registered stand number and name of the company area of the windshield.

Specially marked escape routes or Access roads must always be kept clear.

18. Taking photographs or filming

Commercial photography or filming is on the entire exhibition center only permitted with the consent of Exhibition management.

Photos or films from trade fair operations, trade fair stands and Exhibits made on behalf of the organizer may be used at any time for the organizer's own advertising be used. The exhibitors waive this Copyright.

19. Force Majeure

If the event is cancelled as a result of force majeure or an official order is not carried out the exhibitor will become rent minus 30 percent administrative fee, refunded. Another In this case, the exhibitor is not entitled to compensation.

If parts of the event (special shows or Flight demonstrations / air shows) for higher reasons violence, an official decision, a resolution of the organizer or by decision of third parties cannot take place, the exhibitor is not entitled to compensation or any kind of reimbursement. That applies also for special flight demonstrations that are partially or completely cancelled due to safety concerns.

20. Oral agreements

Oral agreements or agreements with people whatever are, are only valid if the agreements are also confirmed in writing by the fair management.

21. Agreement on jurisdiction and place of performance

Agreement on jurisdiction and place of performance for everyone Legal disputes that arise from a contractual relationship concluded on the occasion of the trade fair event Krefeld.

22. Non-compliance with the trade fair regulations

Non-compliance with these trade fair regulations or the Non-compliance and non-remediation on the part of Defects complained about by the trade fair management within a period specified by the reasonable deadline set by the trade fair management can be granted immediate resolution of the dispute between the exhibitor and the contract concluded with the organizer. Every Business activity can then be prohibited immediately and result in an immediate closure of the trade fair stand.

The trade fair management also reserves the right to do so in such a case a corresponding exhibitor at a subsequent event not to be taken into account.

For the cases listed in this point exhibitors are not entitled to any compensation for damages from the trade fair management and the organizer.

23. Effectiveness of the trade fair regulations

These trade fair regulations are available to the exhibitor with the Registration for this event is effective. With the Registration he accepts these trade fair regulations.
